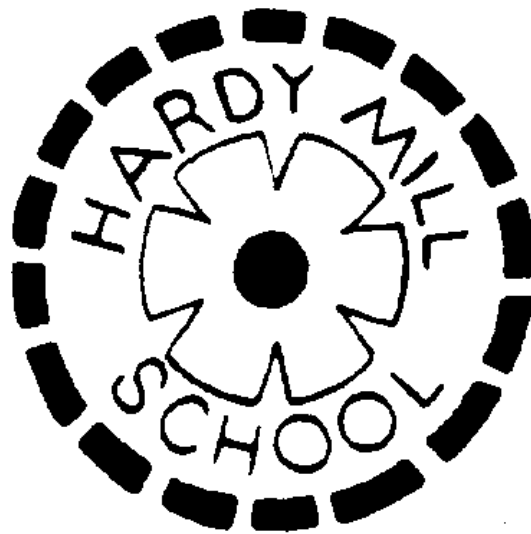


HARDY MILL SCHOOL

UNIFORM INFORMATION



At Hardy Mill Primary School we aim to have a consistent uniform for all children across the school and we appreciate the co-operation of parents and children in helping us to fulfil this aim.

We hope that by wearing uniform and following the rules linked to it, the children at Hardy Mill can be proud to be part of our school. So that no family is put under financial pressure, we have selected uniform that can be purchased from a wide range of suppliers to fit everyone's budget.

Hardy Mill School Uniform

On days when your child's class does not have PE, the following items of clothing are to be worn:

- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Green jumper, green cardigan or green school sweat shirt
- White, green or yellow polo shirt
- Grey or white socks
- Black, flat, sensible shoes (**no trainers or sandals**)

In warm weather, the following items of clothing may be worn:

- Gingham dresses in either yellow and white or green and white
- Grey shorts

'Active Wear' PE Uniform

On the days that your child's class has PE, the following items of clothing are to be worn:

- Plain white T shirt
- Plain black leggings or plain black track suit bottoms/joggers
- Plain black hoodie or zip up top
- Trainers
- Plain black shorts (in warm weather)

These items should not be branded sportswear.

Earrings and watches must not be worn on PE days for health and safety reasons. These should be removed before children come to school, as staff are not be able to remove earrings for the children.

As all children are wearing the same uniform, all items of clothing worn by a child should be clearly named.

Additional information

Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn in school with the exception of:

- plain studs in pierced ears
- a traditional watch (Smart watches are **not** permitted)

Hairstyles

- Haircuts should not be less than a Number 3
- Headbands and bobbles must be plain and in line with school colours
- Shoulder length (or longer) hair should always be tied back for health and safety reasons

Nail varnish and make up are not appropriate for school and must not be worn.
